TONGSUN WITH SECRETARY GENERAL 5/26/93

S.G. will deliver a simple and short message to Tarik in Geneva. He will give him the same message he gave us.

"They should know that the U.S. will object to modifications to 706 and Iraq should start with the Humanitarian thing and if they do not like it then they can stop it."

Only way to resolve the Humanitarian is to come to N.Y.

If they are interested in lifting the sanction then they have to do the Humanitarian first.

S.G. has no surprises and nothing new for Aziz.

Sorensen's stuff will not hold water if they fool around with it. However if Aziz gives him Sorensen's 2 page letter and bring it with him then S.G. will accept it.

Aziz should come with proposal and tell S.G. Iraq accepts SCR 706 as they claim in letter (Sorensen's) except for items unrelated to Humanitarian.

Secretary General: Tell Iraq they have to come as close as possible to SCR 706.

U.S. is testing Iraq's good faith and therefore 3 months at \$1.6 Billion, and if it flies, no one will object to increase.

T.S. will be in Geneva on June 21 for meeting with S.G. prior to meeting with Aziz and has asked for my presence with him with S.G. after my visit with Aziz.

S.G. wants to make sure Aziz understands that in Geneva he will not be allowed to bargain otherwise meeting will be very short and unproductive.
